TCCCC / LINDA LUTOMSKI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Two (2), one-time \$1000.00 scholarships offered: The TCCCC Environmental Scholarship is available to all graduating seniors in Tioga County; the Linda Lutomski Environmental Scholarship is restricted to graduating seniors in the Southern Tioga School District. Students planning to pursue a degree in an environmentally oriented curriculum are eligible.

1. Students will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Class standing – rank as supplied by the Guidance Office. (To be weighted double).
 - b. Scholastic Aptitude Test – mark of scholarship test.
 - c. Recommendation of references – four teachers of subjects taken, chosen by student.
 - d. Activities & Awards – sport, scholastic and community.
 - e. Need – as determined by the scholarship committee. (To be weighted equally with other criteria).
2. Fill out application, return to Guidance Office along with a transcript of grade point average and class rank attached.

4. Applications must be received by May 1st.
5. Scholarships will be judged by a committee of four trustees of the TCCCC.
6. In the case of a tie, the President will decide the winner.
7. The final selection will be announced by the committee.
8. The winner(s) will receive a one-time scholarship of \$1000.00.
